**BOARD OF MANAGERS' MEETING MINUTES**

**JANUARY 13, 2022**

**Approved 3/3/2022**

1. Call To Order

The Board of Managers' January 13, 2022 meeting was called to order at 8:20 am. The meeting was held via Zoom. The following members of the Board were in attendance: Dr. Catherine Arenson (Section President and Balboa), Holly Mack (Academy), Suniqua Thomas (Burton), Tami Benau (Galileo), Shari Balisi Manalang (Lincoln), Joe Dominguez (Lowell), Erik Rice (Marshall), Susan Ryan (O'Connell), Nicholas Chan (SFI), and John Schlauraff (Washington). Commissioner Donald Collins was in attendance. Bill Sanderson and Eric Guthertz from the LEAD-High School Division were also in attendance.

2. Minutes of December 2, 2021 Meeting

The minutes of the December 2, 2021 Board of Managers' meeting were approved by a unanimous vote.

3. Public Comment

Commissioner Donald Collins opened the floor for public comment. There was no public comment.

4. Update on Staff Changes In Athletic Office

Commissioner Collins advised the Board that he had retired on December 31st, and returned from retirement to work until his successor could begin. Mr. Sanderson advised the Board that Gail Barskdale had been selected to replace Mr. Collins, and would begin her term as Commissioner at some point in February. This was an informational item. No action was taken.

5. Update on Upcoming Change In School Composition At Leadership High School

Commissioner Collins advised the Board of a change in school composition at Leadership High School. Leadership will merge with City Arts and Tech

effective in the 2022-23 academic year. This will increase Leadership's population, and it means that students from CAT will no longer be able to play on the June Jordan sports teams since their school will now be part of Leadership High School.

6. Information on Games Postponed Due to COVID/Omicron

Commissioner Collins advised the Board that we have had a substantial number of postponed games due to COVID in basketball, soccer and wrestling. Should the postponements continue at their current pace, there will not be enough time in the league seasons to reschedule them. This is a league issue as opposed to a CIF Section issue. However, the issue could have an impact on Section playoffs.

The Board suggested that the Commissioner, the President and Vice-President of the Board of Managers, and High School and Middle School LEAD meet regarding postponement and rescheduling issues.

7. Information on Suspension of CIF State Bylaw 504(M) (the Sunday Play Prohibition)

The Commissioner informed the Board that the CIF State office has suspended the no Sunday play rule to allow games to be rescheduled to Sunday if necessary during the pandemic. This was an information item. No action was taken.
