BOARD OF MANAGERS' MEETING MINUTES

MARCH 4, 2021

1. Call To Order

The Board of Managers' March 4, 2021 meeting was called to order at 4:00 pm. This meeting was held on-line via Zoom. The following members of the Board were in attendance: Dr. Catherine Arenson (Section President), Michael Jones (Academy), Freedom Siyam (Balboa), Suniqua Thomas (Burton), Tami Benau (Galileo), Shari Balisi Manalang (Lincoln), Dacotah Swett (Lowell), Pirette McKamey (Mission), Tara Hobson (SFI), and John Schlauraff (Washington). Commissioner Donald Collins, and Keasara Williams from the SFUSD Student, Family and Community Support Division *were also in attendance.*

2. Minutes of February 4, 2021 Meeting

The minutes of the February 4, 2021 Board of Managers' meeting were approved by a unanimous vote.

3. Public Comment

Commissioner Donald Collins opened the floor for public comment. There was no public comment.

4. Return to Play Update

A. General Reopening Information

The Commissioner and the Board noted that San Francisco Unified School District schools have not moved to reopen sports, but discussed various scenarios that may lead District schools to return to play. This was a discussion item. No action was taken.

B. Proposal To Move Flag Football From Season One to Season Two To Match District's Scheduling Plan

The Board and Commissioner discussed a return to play plan under which the District may allow flag football and certain other outdoor sports. The Board noted that the San Francisco Section's season of sport for flag football had already ended.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted 10-0 to entertain an emergency item, moving flag football into season two, and giving flag football a season of sport running from April to the end of June. This was a unanimous vote of the members present for the meeting.

After voting to entertain the emergency measure, the Board voted 10 – 0 to move the flag football season into season two. This was a unanimous vote of the members present for the meeting.

C. Update on Fencing

The Commissioner advised the Board that the non-SFUSD schools in our fencing league are preparing for the season. SFUSD schools are not authorized to compete at present; so the non-SFUSD fencing schools will only compete against each other.

The Commissioner also advised the Board that the CDPH has classified fencing as a low-contact sport, but has classified it as an outdoor sport. The Athletic Office has moved fencing from indoor to outdoors until such time as we either reach the lowest of the State's safety tiers or the CDPH gives fencing an indoor classification. The non-SFUSD schools are able to make the adjustment from indoor to outdoor fencing.

5. CIF Federated Council Items For April Federated Council

The Commissioner gave first readings to the following CIF State items that will be voting items at the State's April, 2021 Federated Council.:

- A. Executive Committee Nominees – First Reading
- B. CIF Budget – First Reading
- C. Competitive Cheer Sunday Exception – First Reading

These items will be brought before our Board of Managers for a vote at the San Francisco Section's April Board of Managers' meeting.

6. Multi-School Renewals – First Reading

The Commissioner gave a first reading to a proposal to renew the Section's multi-schools for 2021-22. This matter will be returned as a voting item in April.
