BOARD OF MANAGERS' MEETING MINUTES
MAY 13, 2021

1. Call To Order

The Board of Managers' May 3, 2021 meeting was called to order at 4:20 pm. This meeting was held on-line via Zoom. The following members of the Board were in attendance: Dr. Catherine Arenson (Section President), Michael Jones (Academy), Freedom Siyam (Balboa), Suniqua Thomas (Burton), Tami Benau (Galileo), Shari Balisi Manalang (Lincoln), Mark Heringer (Marshall), Pirette McKamey (Mission), Vincent Toan (O'Connell), and John Schlauraff (Washington). Commissioner Donald Collins, and Bill Sanderson were **also in attendance**.

2. Minutes of April 8, 2021 Meeting

The minutes of the April 8, 2021 Board of Managers' meeting were approved by a vote of 10-0. This was a unanimous vote of the members present for the meeting.

3. Public Comment

Commissioner Donald Collins opened the floor for public comment. There was no public comment.

4. Summer Facilities Access For Weight Training/Conditioning/Open Gym

The Board discussed summer facilities access. The Board members noted that school sites had been closed throughout the spring semester, and discussed procedures for summer reopening for conditioning and weight lifting, as well as procedures football teams should follow to access school sites when they begin practicing in July.

Bill Sanderson, the head of the High School LEAD Office, advised the Board that

he would work with facilities and the Student, Families, Community Support Division on summer access issues.

This was not a voting item so no formal action was taken.

5. Updates on 2020-21 Security – In Case We Don't Have SRO Access

The Commissioner advised the Board that the District had not begun work on a plan to replace SRO coverage at athletic contests, and would begin working on the issue over the summer.

6. Return to Play Update

The Board discussed issues arising from the Section's return to play in late April/early May, following the COVID related suspension of sports during the 2020-21 academic year. The Board was pleased to see sports return. There was discussion of the low number of participants, and facilities access. There was concern as to what things will look like in the fall.

7. Issues For 2021-22

The Board noted the need to develop a security plan for the replacements of SROs. The Board also noted the need to follow up on the summer facilities access issues.

8. Nominations for Vice-President – For A Term That Expires on June 30, 2023

Suniqua Thomas was nominated to serve another term as vice-president. She will run unopposed for this position at the Board's next meeting.
