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BOARD OF MANAGERS' MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 4, 2021

1. Call To Order

The Board of Managers' November 4, 2021 meeting was called to order at 8:12 am at O'Connell High School. The following members of the Board were in attendance: Dr. Catherine Arenson (Section President and Balboa), Holly Mack (Academy), Suniqua Thomas (Burton), Tami Benau (Galileo), Shari Balisi Manalang (Lincoln), Joe Dominguez (Lowell), Mark Heringer (Marshall), Pirette McKamey (Mission), Susan Ryan (O'Connell), Nicholas Chan (SFI), and John Schlauraff (Washington). Commissioner Donald Collins was in attendance. Bill Sanderson and Eric Guthertz from the LEAD-High School Division were also in attendance.

2. Minutes of October 12, 2021 Meeting

The minutes of the October 12, 2021 Board of Managers' meeting were approved by a unanimous vote.

3. Public Comment

Commissioner Donald Collins opened the floor for public comment. There was no public comment.

4. CIF Federated Council Items

The Board instructed its Federated Council voting representatives to vote in favor of the following proposals at the next CIF State Federated Council meeting:

A. Proposal to Adjust Sections' Weighted Votes Due to Number of Schools and Enrollment Changes.

B. Proposal to Adjust Federated Council At-Large Member's Term of Office, and Clarification of Term of Federated Council members who retire during their term in office.

C. Proposal to reduce the number of nominees for CIF State Executive Committee spots.

The Board's vote on these items was unanimous.

5. Follow Up on Discussion of Impact of School Early Release Times on Athletics

The Board continued its discussion of the impact of school late release times on athletics. The Board discussed a number of possible adjustments, expressing a preference to not have night games, and Saturday games if possible. The Board also noted that it would wish to have broad discussions in the spring regarding schedule formats and the possibility of adjusting league scheduling to adjust for the late release times. This was a discussion item so no action was taken.

6. Preparation For Winter Sports – Discussion of Site Security/Game Management Issues

The Board discussed security arrangements for winter sports. The Board asked the Commissioner to re-send a list of winter sports contests being covered by the Mayor's Street Violence Intervention Program (SVIP), and by T-10s and the Black Bear private security guards.

7. Cheer, Wrestling and Swimming COVID Testing – Discussion Item

The Commissioner and Board discussed the weekly COVID testing for competitive cheer, wrestling and swimming athletes. The testing is a prerequisite for them being allowed to go maskless when they practice and/or compete.

The Commissioner noted that the District's initial testing sites were not on high school campuses, forcing students to travel to other schools for testing. The Board provided information as to when test kits would be available at high school sites. The Commissioner will advise the schools that have athletes who are required to test.

8. Vacation Site Reservations

The Commissioner and Board discussed schools' need to reserve their sites if they wish to practice over Thanksgiving and Winter break.

9. Athletic Office Staffing Information

The Commissioner updated the Board of Managers on changes in athletic office personnel.

10. Adjourn
