VIII. Action Items – President Arenson

A. Type: New CIF Sanctioned Sport; Bylaw Addition and Revision

- i. **Summary:** A proposal has been forwarded from the CIF/Southern Section to add the sport of flag football as a CIF sanctioned sport for girls. The proposal would add Flag Football to the list of approved sports in CIF Bylaw 1200, revise Article 60 and Bylaw 2100.
- ii. **Fiscal Impact:** There is no fiscal impact to the CIF at this time as it is not being proposed as a championship event. There, of course, would be costs involved for CIF member schools choosing to offer this as a sport.
- iii. **Background:** One of the CIF goals is to increase participation opportunities for girls in order to close the gap between the number of girls and boys participants. Currently there are girls flag football programs at over 100 CIF member schools with over 1,300 girls participating in those programs. In addition, there are five states that offer the sport for girls.

B. Type: Constitutional Amendment (Requires a two-thirds vote of the Federated Council)

- i. **Summary:** This Constitutional Amendment would require CIF member schools to complete the participation census each year and identifies sanctions when schools fail to do so.
- ii. **Fiscal Impact:** None
- iii. **Background:** Approximately 10-12% of CIF member schools fail to submit the census on a yearly basis. This results in a negative impact on the overall reporting of participation numbers and other data related to member schools of the CIF. It is also California law (Education Code Section 221.9) that schools offering competitive interscholastic athletics report on their school website (or district website if no school site exists) information about boys' and girls' athletic participation by the end of each school year.
